By registering for open classes with BSDA, I acknowledge and agree to the following policies and procedures:

- Refunds are not permitted, please only book a class when you are sure you can attend. Spots are transferable, so you are permitted to give your spot to someone else but you would need to handle requesting payment from them.

Medical Emergency

The undersigned gives permission to Brandon and/or Bay-Area School of Dance Arts ("BSDA"), its owners and operators to seek medical treatment for your child (children) in the event they are not able to reach a parent or guardian. I certify that my child is physically able to participate in dance activities and that I have disclosed any medical conditions, injuries, allergies, or limitations that may affect participation. I understand that I am financially responsible for any medical treatment rendered.

Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Hold Harmless Agreement

I understand and acknowledge that participation in dance classes, rehearsals, performances, competitions, conventions, camps, private lessons, conditioning, stretching, acrobatics, tumbling, choreography sessions, travel-related activities, and all other activities conducted by or associated with Brandon and/or Bay-Area School of Dance Arts ("BSDA") involves inherent risks of injury and physical exertion.

These risks may include, but are not limited to: slips, falls, collisions, sprains, strains, broken bones, head injuries, concussions, paralysis, illness, emotional distress, permanent disability, and death. I understand that injuries may result from participation in activities, use of equipment, physical corrections by instructors, actions of other participants, facility conditions, or other known and unknown risks inherent in dance and athletic activities.

I voluntarily choose to allow my child (or myself, if an adult participant) to participate in BSDA activities and I knowingly and freely assume all risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the ordinary negligence of BSDA, its owners, directors, instructors, employees, independent contractors, volunteers, assistants, representatives, affiliates, or agents, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

On behalf of myself, my child, our heirs, assigns, personal representatives, and next of kin, I hereby release, waive, discharge, covenant not to sue, and hold harmless Brandon and/or Bay-Area School of Dance Arts ("BSDA"), its owners, operators, directors, instructors, employees, contractors, volunteers, affiliates, representatives, and agents from any and all claims, liabilities, demands, damages, costs, expenses, actions, or causes of action of any kind whatsoever arising out of or related to participation in any BSDA activity, including but not limited to claims arising from personal injury, illness, property damage, emotional distress, disability, or death.

I understand and acknowledge that BSDA does not provide medical insurance for participants and that I am solely responsible for any and all medical expenses, emergency transportation, treatment, or other costs incurred as a result of participation.

I certify that the participant is physically able to safely participate in dance-related activities and that I have disclosed any known medical conditions, injuries, allergies, restrictions, or limitations that may affect participation. I understand that it is my responsibility to update the studio regarding any changes to the participant's medical condition.

I understand that instructors may provide physical corrections, spotting, or assistance during instruction for purposes of safety, technique, or training.

In the event of an emergency, I authorize BSDA and its representatives to obtain emergency medical treatment for the participant if a parent/guardian cannot be reached immediately. I understand that I remain fully responsible for all resulting medical expenses.

I further acknowledge that participation in BSDA activities may involve exposure to illnesses, including but not limited to contagious or communicable illnesses, and I voluntarily assume such risks associated with participation in group activities.

I agree that if any portion of this agreement is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

By signing below, I acknowledge that I have carefully read this Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Hold Harmless Agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I am giving up substantial legal rights by signing it, and sign it freely and voluntarily without inducement.

Photography and Media Release:

I grant permission for BSDA to photograph or record my child during dance classes, rehearsals, and performances for promotional and educational purposes. I understand that these photos or recordings may be used on BSDA's website, social media platforms, marketing materials, or for press releases. I understand that no compensation will be provided for the use of such photographs or recordings. These materials may be used in current or future promotional materials.

Right to Refuse Service

BSDA reserves the right to refuse or discontinue service to any student or family whose behavior is determined to be disruptive, inappropriate, unsafe, threatening, or not aligned with the values and expectations of the studio environment.

Illness and Safety

Students should not attend class while ill, feverish, contagious, or medically unable to safely participate.

Parents are responsible for notifying the studio of injuries, medical conditions, allergies, or limitations that may affect participation.

Agreement:

If any portion of these policies is determined to be unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
